The Proposed Development includes the installation of ground mounted solar arrays, battery energy storage system and associated development comprising grid connection infrastructure and other infrastructure integral to the construction, operation and maintenance of the development for the delivery of over 50 megawatts (MW) of electricity

The site is entirely within North Yorkshire Council's administrative boundary on predominantly agricultural land. Selby, the nearest main settlement, is about 1.5km north of the site. Other nearby settlements include Cablesforth (immediately north), Hirst Courtney (400m south), Temple Hirst (600m south-west), Carlton (900m south), Drax (500m east), Barlow (1.4km north-east), and Burn (1.7km west). The Drax Power Station (immediately north) and Eggborough Power Station (3.3km south-west) are prominent features in the surrounding landscape. The site is shown on the Location and Order Limits Plan [EN010140/APP/2.1].

Under the bilateral agreement, the Applicant and its appointed contractors will be responsible for designing, gaining consent, building, and decommissioning the following for the grid connection: constructing the HREP On Site 132kV substation and associated on-site cabling works; installing cabling between the HREP On Site 132kV substation and the new generator bay within Drax 132kV National Grid Substation; populating a new generator bay within the Drax 132kV National Grid Substation, including cable sealing ends, switchgear, and associated

structures; and installing control and protection, monitoring, communication, and metering systems in a new enclosure within the Drax National Grid Substation.

Under the bilateral connection agreement, NGENSO and NGET are responsible for designing, gaining consent for, and building the enabling and reinforcement works in accordance with the Security and Quality of Supply Standard (SQSS), which sets out the criteria and methodology for planning and operating the National Electricity Transmission System (NETS). The enabling reinforcement works include extending busbars at Drax 132kV Substation to accommodate the new generator bay connection and conducting a civil infrastructure survey to evaluate the bay infrastructure ratings of the bus coupler and bus section circuit breakers (120 and 130) at Drax 132kV Substation.
