DEADLINE 2 - WRITTEN REPRESENTATIONS; COMMENTS ON ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION / SUBMISSIONS RECEIVED BY DEADLINE 1; AND UPDATED PADS.

We submitted our Relevant Representation (RR) [RR-117] dated 30/09/2024. The applicant provided a response to these representations in the subsequent document [REP1-004] *The Applicants Responses to Relevant Representations*.

The Written Representations presented below have been made in response to REP1-004.

Environment Agency position

Overall we are satisfied that we are in continuing productive discussions with the Applicant and that progress is being made across all the issues raised in RR-117. At this time, we have no substantive changes to the PADs.

<u>Regarding flood risk.</u> The applicant has issued a technical note dated 07.01.2025 to address all the flood risk matters raised in [RR-117]. We are reviewing this technical note and have agreed to provide our response to the applicant in time to allow their further response at Deadline 3.

<u>Regarding Groundwater.</u> We are satisfied that all issues raised in [RR-117] are being addressed. Solutions to all concerns have been agreed in principle with the applicant, and we anticipate these will be closed down following the submission of amended documents and additional detail.
