Hi Robert

As discussed on the phone, the examination timetable is different to what was

understood from our telephone conversation on Monday 16th September. It is disappointing that the Tillbridge Team were put in a position of not having received the formal Rule 6 letter in sufficient time to allow time for standard publicity at 21 days as set out in the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rule 2010.

I have attached a copy of the notice marked 'FINAL'

This will be published in the Lincolnshire Echo and Retford Times this week, so has met the statutory newspaper advertising requirements for 21-days associated with the PM and ISH1. For completeness & consistency with publishing previous notices, we will also publish in the Gainsborough Standard edition next week.

I believe that there are two options:

- Can the ExA direct that we can issue another notice with the correct hearing details with less than 21 days' notice before the preliminary meeting, as allowed for under Rule 13(6) of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rule 2010, or
- 2. Written agreement and direction from the ExA that a second notice can be issued as a correction to the first notice but only displayed in Gainsborough Standard next week. We would need a written direction from the ExA that the second notice has less than 21 day's notice before the PM overall in accordance with Rule 13(6) of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rule 2010.

Option 2 is our preferred approach subject to written agreement from the ExA.

In terms of Rule 13 (6) of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rule 2010, we can confirm that our team will post and maintain notices close to the Order limits (Rule 13 (6) (a) and will display notices in parish council notices boards to meet Rule 13 (6) (b). These will be displayed from the 23 September 2024. In terms of placing the updated notice in the Gainsborough Standard, this would meet Rule 13 (6) (c) being a newspaper circulating in the locality in which the application relates.

I have attached an amended version of the notice to be published in the Gainsborough Standard.

If you could come back to me asap so that we do not miss the deadline in the Gainsborough Standard, that would be appreciated.
