I have numerous concerns and many unanswered questions from other solar project hearings which already approved will have a huge negative impact on a very large concentrated area with many inhabitants and wildlife.

Other projects have already been approved in this area which simply cannot take anymore of this without destroying the local economy/ farming and destruction to the financial health and wellbeing of many who will be forced to live amongst a battery of solar panels and huge collection batteries.
