I just wanted to ask if anyone has worked with local estate agents to assess the damage of surrounding our properties and villages with solar farms. And why I should be the one who makes a loss.

Where can I go to claim compensation for the losses that will be made on my property?

I just wanted to point out I have looked at putting solar panels on my roof but the price was over 10k so couldn't afford them. But if the government put solar panels on our roofs instead of farmland we would have the power we need, keep the farmland and keep the value to our properties. So everyone wins.

Before you consider this solar farm I would like you to ask tillbridge to speak to me again about the field directly next to my house. [REDACTED] they have said that they will put wild flowers in half of it but I would like to ask them to put the flowers all the way up to the trees in that field. Especially as I have [REDACTED] in that area too. I don't think this is an unreasonable request.

(In this hearing they said they would contact me directly but they still haven't). Please could you ask them to do so before you make your decision).
