The Canal & River Trust ("the Trust") has been asked by the Examining Authority (ExA) to respond at Deadline 3 to their first written questions and requests for information (ExQ1).

Q1.10.20 - The Trust agrees that the protective provisions secure appropriate management of construction effects, including those resulting from noise and vibration, to limit impacts on users of the river.

The Applicant is aware that we are waiting for the next updates to the Outline Design Principles and Scheme Description documents, so they capture drilling depth specifications that fully mirror the wording used in the consented Gate Burton and Cottam Solar Projects and as included within the draft documents for the West Burton Solar Project.
