

The Scheme comprises the construction, operation (including maintenance) and decommissioning of a solar photovoltaic array electricity generating facility with a total capacity exceeding 50 megawatts and export connection to the national grid, at National Grid's Drax Substation.

The deadline date for all representations to be received by the Secretary of State under section 56 was 23:59 on 8 March 2024.
