This project impacts our area negatively and the cumulative impact is devastating, we already have wind turbines which impact the skyline, they are noisy and the shadow flicker is distressing to those affected. The houses in Spaldington are already impacted by this and now you are compounding their misery by allowing 1000's of solar panels to invade their personal space. Speak to the residents of this tiny village, it is bringing them to tears at the thought and impacting their mental health. Personal rights need to be taken into account not just overriding them to meet a Government target. We also have had an anaerobic digester thrust upon us in this locality. We have had our fair share surely of the burden of modern living forced upon us by now, no more please!

This project covers the area of equivalent of building approx 50,000 houses but nearby Howden is already building 1000's of new homes on green belt farmland and now you are proposing to remove another 3000 acres from the food chain. You are building on land in this rural area the equivalent of the city of Hereford, impacting on farming, food production and infrastructure.

Ambulance and fire services are already stretched here, by building this industrial complex in the middle of nowhere the current fire service provision could not cope if there was a major incident again putting the local population at heightened risk, who's paying for the extra emergency service provision that will be needed to cover this new industrial estate from the fire risk?

Wildlife will be adversely affected, less habitat, less variety and diversity. More large animals on the main roads which will in turn cause more road traffic accidents, again putting the locals at heightened risk.

This is not the place to build an industrial project which will be one of a cluster, again impacting on the locals because of it's proximity to Drax.
