Last night when having a look through Booms application I found a map of our properties and land, and also that of our neighbours at [REDACTED]

This map had a dotted line across it! I then discovered that it is the line of a connecting cable which Boom are planning to run under our land. This was never shown on maps when we went to their public meetings on 24th May, 10th June and 13th June 2023

The documents are so vast a person would need months of free time to be able to troll through ALL the documents.

Boom have NEVER contacted us regarding the laying of this cable under our land.

Please note that Boom are using outdated Ordnance Survey Maps

I have attached Booms Choice of ordnance map and a true Ordnance Survey Map dated 2016

Please can you ensure that the Inspector is aware that

a) Boom have not contacted us regarding the route of the cable across our land (there are other choices of routes for the cable).

B) Boom are conveniently using OLD outdated Ordnance Maps
