Springwell Solar Farm: pre-submission engagement on consultation process

I am writing regarding Springwell Solar Farm – a proposed new solar farm and battery storage facility located in North Kesteven, Lincolnshire. The proposals also include infrastructure to connect Springwell Solar Farm to the National Grid and any necessary supporting site infrastructure and environmental mitigation, including landscaping.

As Principal Project Development Manager at EDF Renewables, I have recently taken over from following his retirement, and I am looking forward to working with you on the Springwell project.

Springwell Solar Farm is classed as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project ('NSIP') under the Planning Act 2008 because the amount of electricity it would generate is over 50 megawatts ('MW'). This means we need to apply for a Development Consent Order ('DCO') to build and operate it.

Our proposals for Springwell Solar Farm have been shaped by an iterative programme of pre-application consultation and engagement. This has included two phases of formal consultation on the proposals, targeted consultation on improvements to the highways and footpath network in parallel with ongoing engagement with key stakeholders, including near neighbours, statutory consultees and the host authorities. A full summary of pre-application consultation and engagement undertaken in support of the proposals will be provided in the Consultation Report submitted as part of our DCO application.

Why we are writing to you

On 30 April 2024, the Planning Inspectorate published updated guidance on the NSIP preapplication process, which included the introduction of an Adequacy of Consultation Milestone ('AoCM'). The AoCM is intended to reduce the burden on local authorities during the acceptance stage through pre-submission engagement on the consultation process. Specifically, it is advised that the AoCM should:

- establish the consultation undertaken to date:
- confirm the approach set out in the Statement of Community Consultation: and
- summarise the consultation responses and the way in which they are shaping the application.

We recognise the value in working collaboratively with local authorities at this important stage in the DCO process. While it is understood that the



AoCM is expected to apply to projects that have not yet commenced formal consultation, we are keen to accommodate engagement with host authorities on some elements of the AoCM prior to submitting our DCO application. Records of this engagement will be sent to the Planning Inspectorate and published on the project page in line with the updated guidance.

As discussed at our meeting on 22 August 2024, our pre-submission engagement for the AoCM will focus on how consultation on Springwell Solar Farm has complied with the commitments set out in our Statement of Community Consultation ('SoCC') - including how feedback from host authorities helped to shape the SoCC. We are proposing to undertake this pre-submission engagement in parallel with our continued technical engagement with both North Kesteven District Council and Lincolnshire County Council.

This letter sets out a list of meetings held, headline topics discussed and how this has influenced our approach to consultation. In the first instance, we would be grateful if you could review this summary ahead of discussion at our regularly programmed meetings. It is intended that we will use the meetings to share draft documents relevant to the AoCM and give an overview of the pre-application consultation and engagement undertaken to date. Discussion at these meetings will help to inform a written response from both local authorities on completion of the AoCM.

Summary of engagement

Engagement with the host authorities has helped to shape our approach to consultation. This has included a programme of fortnightly meetings between officers and members of the project team that focussed on planning and communications. Since its inception (15 March 2023), these meetings have provided the opportunity to discuss key elements of the Springwell project as it has evolved.

Through these meetings, we have built long-term working relationships with officers and have received valuable inputs that have shaped our proposals. We would like to thank officers for their continued engagement throughout the pre-application process.

This programme of meetings has complemented the technical engagement between specialist officers and members of the project team on environmental assessments.

Adequacy of Consultation Milestone – response by North Kesteven District Council

I refer to your letter dated 10 September 2024 and further email dated 13 September 2024 enclosing your Draft Consultation Response Appendix D-4: Compliance with the SoCC (the main Consultation Report and other Appendices were not provided) and a slide presentation (dated 13.09.24) describing how the proposals have evolved since its inception.

The Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIP) Pre-Application Prospectus 2024 introduced the Adequacy of Consultation Milestone (AoCM) to allow early consideration of the adequacy of consultation undertaken by the applicant at pre-application stage by the Planning Inspectorate. The written submission to the Inspectorate may include the views of local authorities.

This letter provides the views of North Kesteven District Council to EDF, as the developer for the Springwell Solar Farm, to help inform their written submission on the AoCM as part of the DCO submission process.

The guidance within the Prospectus sets out that the written submission should cover:

- The consultation undertaken to date,
- The approaches set out in the Statement of Community Consultation, and
- Summarises the consultation responses and the way in which they are shaping the application.

For the purposes of the AoCM, we note that, given the respective timescales for the release of the 2024 Prospectus and the advanced preparation of a DCO application for the solar farm; focus has primarily been on the first two matters. To this end, we have reviewed the Draft Consultation Response Appendix D-4: Compliance with the SoCC which you have kindly shared with us.

I can confirm that the project team has engaged with the Council throughout the preapplication process, particularly through fortnightly technical liaison meetings between officers and members of the project team which included discussions on the approach to consultation. The Council has been offered the opportunity to comment on the draft Statement of Community Consultation and our comments were taken on board prior to the statutory consultation being undertaken (Jan-Feb 2024). A similar level of engagement was carried out around the second statutory consultation exercise on proposed amendments to the red line (August 2024).

With regard to the third matter, I can confirm that we have not been party to detailed information about how the consultation responses have shaped the proposals nor the likely environmental impacts of the changes. However, through the fortnightly liaison meetings; we have been kept informed, albeit at a high level, of the amendments to the proposals in relation to technical matters such as impacts on land use/agricultural land impacts, public rights of way, flood risk, landscape and visual impact and ecology particularly where this have sought to overcome or minimise adverse environmental impacts highlighted through the consultation process with statutory and non-statutory consultees. These were summarised in a presentation by the project team on 12 September 2024.


The high level of engagement with the Council over the pre-application period is to be commended. We are satisfied that, at this stage and based on the information provided, an adequate level of consultation has been carried out subject to the following caveat.

This response is made without prejudice to the formal response that will be provided by the Council to the statutory Adequacy of Consultation requirements under s42, 47 and 48 of the Planning Act 2008, once a DCO application has been made and the full Consultation report has been submitted, and to the scope of the Council's representations through its LIR and Written Representations once the application is accepted for examination.

Adequacy of Consultation Request – Application by Springwell Energy Farm Ltd for a Development Consent Order for Springwell Solar Farm in North Kesteven District, Lincolnshire

Thank you for your letter of 10 September 2024, and the follow up email on 13 September 2024, which included your Draft Consultation Response Appendix D-4: Compliance with the SoCC. Please note the main Consultation Report and other Appendices were not provided. Additionally, a slide presentation (dated 13th September 2024) detailed how the proposals have evolved since inception.

The Adequacy of Consultation Milestone (AoCM) was introduced through the Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIP) Pre-Application Prospectus in 2024, and aims to facilitate an earlier consideration of the adequacy of consultation undertaken by the applicant at pre-application stage by the Planning Inspectorate. The written submission to the Inspectorate may include the views of local authorities.

The Prospectus sets out that written submissions should cover:

- The consultation undertaken to date
- The approaches set out in the Statement of Community Consultation
- Summarises the Consultation responses and the way in which they are shaping the application.

In response to your request for a view from Lincolnshire County Council on the adequacy of consultation and having had regard to Section 42 (Duty to consult), 47 (Duty to consult the local community) and 48 (Duty to publicise) of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended). I can confirm that Lincolnshire County Council is of the view that Springwell Solar Energy Ltd to date has carried out adequate pre-application consultation in accordance with the requirements as set out in Sections 42, 47 and 48 of the Act.

The Applicant commenced early engagement with Lincolnshire County Council from March 2023 and, regular meetings with the Planning Lead together with technical meetings with other specialist council officers and its consultants have taken place throughout the majority of the pre-application process. Springwell Energy Farm Ltd formally consulted the Council on the draft Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC) in September 2023.

There has been active engagement between the Springwell project team and Lincolnshire County Council throughout the pre-application process. This has included regular liaison meetings between council officers and the project team every two weeks. The approach to consultation has been a key topic of discussion at relevant times. The Council has been given the opportunity to review and provide feedback on the draft SoCC and our feedback was taken into account prior to the commencement of statutory consultation (PIER) in January 2024. The Council were also consulted in respect of consultation in advance of the second statutory consultation exercise in August 2024, on proposed amendments to the red line boundary.

The Council has not been provided with any specific detailed information on how the consultation responses have shaped the application, however, we have been kept up to date on amendments to the proposals through the 2 weekly liaison meetings, and have been invited to discuss our comments from the consultations and agree mitigation measures at topic based technical meetings in relation to highway, public rights of way, agricultural land, landscape and visual and ecology matters. A summary of the changes to the proposal was presented by the Springwell project team to Council officers on 12th September 2024.

Lincolnshire County Council is therefore satisfied that an appropriate level of consultation has been conducted at this stage.
