## Formal Notification of Project Name Change

As has been discussed with you previously, we are writing to formally notify you of a change in the name of the project formerly titled 'Great North Road Solar Park'. Effective immediately, the project will be referred to as 'Great North Road Solar and Biodiversity Park'.

This is in reflection of the recent partnerships Elements Green has formed with the RSPB, Sherwood Forest Trust, Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust, and The Trent Rivers Trust to ensure a holistic approach to mitigation and enhancement across the scheme.

Communities who were consulted on the initial proposals expressed a strong interest in the protection and enhancement of their natural environment. Acting upon this feedback, Elements Green has formed partnerships with these nature charities and trusts, which will be instrumental in the implementation of new woodland, grassland habitats, trees, and wetlands, for example.

The Applicant (Elements Green Trent Ltd) remains the same, and the change of name has been communicated ahead of undertaking statutory consultation in the new year. This includes the distribution of a press release to relevant regional and trade outlets and updating the project website (www.gnrsolarpark.co.uk). The name change will be reflected in all project documentation to be published as part of our upcoming statutory consultation including the Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC).
