Further to the response which I submitted on 21st May, the County Council would wish to make the following additional comments with respect to Rights of Way:

The information that is required for RoW should appear in the Section 14 Transport and Access as they are part of the minor highways network.

This section should cover the RoW network that is affected, confirmed by a formal search of the Definitive Map and Statement for Public Rights of Way to Row Landsearches row.landsearches@nottscc.gov.uk

They should consider:

- If/where the development affects the RoW network
- can the network be accommodated without diversion within the design of the site(s).
- is there a strong reason to consider a permanent diversion of the path(s) if required
- is there a temporary effect on the network during construction (requiring temporary closures for public safety) can alternative/phase ed temporary routes be considered for the duration
- is there an opportunity to create a new paths to link the network where there may be a missing link or a clear need to connect to areas
- the design of the paths to include a buffer area/green corridor that the RoW sit within
- maintenance regime for the duration of the development

The amenity of the use of the network would be considered in a separate section under Section 7 Landscape Appraisal.
