We previously wrote to you to consult you on National Grid Electricity Transmission plc's (here on referred to as National Gird) proposals to reinforce the transmission network between the existing Bramford Substation in Suffolk, and Twinstead Tee in Essex. We are now writing to you to consult you on some changes we propose to make prior to submitting our Application for development consent.

Our proposals

The reinforcement would comprise up to 18 km of overhead line (consisting of approximately 50 new pylons, and conductors) and 11 km of underground cable system (consisting of up to 21 cables with associated joint bays and above ground link pillars).

Four Cable Sealing End (CSE) Compounds would be required to facilitate the transition between the overhead and underground cable technology. The CSE would be within a fenced compound, and contain electrical equipment, support structures, a small control building and a permanent access track.

It is proposed that approximately 27 km of existing overhead line and associated pylons would be removed as part of the proposals. This would comprise 25 km of existing 132 kV overhead line between Burstall Bridge and Twinstead Tee, and 2 km of the existing 400 kV overhead line to the south of Twinstead Tee. To facilitate the overhead line removal, a new grid supply point (GSP) substation is required at Butler's Wood, east of Wickham St Paul, in Essex. The GSP substation would include associated works, including replacement pylons, a single circuit sealing end

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compound and underground cables to connect the substation into the existing 400 kV and 132 kV networks.

Other ancillary activities would be required to facilitate construction and operation of the project. These would include modifications to sections of the existing 400 kV overhead line, temporary working areas, diversion of third-party assets, land drainage from the construction and operational footprint, and land required for mitigation and Biodiversity Net Gain.

The project meets the threshold as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP), as defined under Part 3 of the Planning Act 2008 ("the Act"), hence National Grid requires a development consent order (DCO).

Proposed changes to the project

Since our consultations last year, further work has been undertaken to progress the design of the project, and we have carefully considered all feedback received. As a result, we have made changes to the Project which affect your interest in land, so we are consulting you under Sections 42 and 44 of the Act.

These include:

- Realignment of the proposed temporary haul road between the A131 and the proposed Stour Valley West Cable Sealing End Compound, west of Alphamstone
- Additional land incorporated into the order limits (maximum area of land required for construction and operation of the proposed reinforcement) to accommodate the maximum swing of conductors (wires) on existing 400 kV transmission overhead lines, and
- Other minor changes to the order limits for construction and operational activities including access.



Application for Development Consent

We have recently become aware that you may own, occupy or have a legal interest in land that could be affected by National Grid Electricity Transmission plc's ("National Grid") proposed Bramford to Twinstead Reinforcement Project (the "Project"). This may be because you have recently bought, leased or secured an interest in land which may be affected by the Project. As such, you may not have received a letter from National Grid informing you of previous statutory consultations for the Project and explaining how you can provide comments on the Project.

National Grid intends to submit an application for an order granting development consent to reinforce the transmission network between the existing Bramford Substation in Suffolk, and Twinstead Tee in Essex. This would be achieved by the construction and operation of a new 400 kilovolt (kV) electricity transmission line over a distance of approximately 29 km.

The project meets the threshold as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP), as defined under Part 3 of the Planning Act 2008 ("the Act"), hence National Grid requires a development consent order (DCO).

Our proposals

The reinforcement would comprise up to 18 km of overhead line (consisting of approximately 50 new pylons, and conductors) and 11 km of underground cable system (consisting of up to 21 cables with associated joint bays and above ground link pillars).

Four Cable Sealing End (CSE) Compounds would be required to facilitate the transition between the overhead and underground cable technology. The CSE would

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be within a fenced compound, and contain electrical equipment, support structures, a small control building and a permanent access track.

It is proposed that approximately 27 km of existing overhead line and associated pylons would be removed as part of the proposals. This would comprise 25 km of existing 132 kV overhead line between Burstall Bridge and Twinstead Tee, and 2 km of the existing 400 kV overhead line to the south of Twinstead Tee. To facilitate the overhead line removal, a new grid supply point (GSP) substation is required at Butler's Wood, east of Wickham St Paul, in Essex. The GSP substation would include associated works, including replacement pylons, a single circuit sealing end compound and underground cables to connect the substation into the existing 400 kV and 132 kV networks.

Other ancillary activities would be required to facilitate construction and operation of the project. These would include modifications to sections of the existing 400 kV overhead line, temporary working areas, diversion of third-party assets, land drainage from the construction and operational footprint, and land required for mitigation and Biodiversity Net Gain. Although the period to respond to the consultation for the Project has now passed, you will still have the opportunity to register your interest to participate in the examination of the application for development consent once the application is made. National Grid intends to submit the application for development consent to the Planning Inspectorate in April 2023. Should the Planning Inspectorate accept the application for examination, we will send to you a letter explaining how to register your interest to participate in the examination and make representations (giving notice of your interest in, or comments in respect of National Grid's application for the Project).
