Seating will be available at the venue 30 minutes prior to the start. The Hearing will finish when the ExA considers that all participants have had their say and all matters have been covered. Depending on the numbers wishing to speak, it may be necessary for the ExA to limit the time allocated to each speaker.

All Hearings are recorded, and the recordings will be made available on the <u>project webpage</u> as soon as practicable after the close of the Hearing.
