### **The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 – Rule 17**

#### **Application by National Grid Electricity Transmission plc for an Order granting Development Consent for the Bramford to Twinstead Reinforcement**

The Applicant submitted its final 'Compulsory Acquisition and Temporary Possession Objections Schedule' (document 8.4.4 (F) [Examination Library reference to be confirmed]) and 'Applicant's Protective Provisions and Commercial Side Agreements Tracking List' (document 8.7.8 (E) [Examination Library reference to be confirmed]) at Deadline 9 in the Examination Timetable. At Deadline 8 the Applicant also submitted 'Application under Section 127 Planning Act 2008 – Network Rail Infrastructure Limited' [REP8-037] and an 'Application under Section 138 Planning Act 2008 – Statutory Undertakers Telecommunications Operators' Rights and Apparatus' (Document 8.11.4) [Examination Library reference to be confirmed]. The Examining Authority similarly requests you to respond to these as necessary.

The Examining Authority asks that you submit the requested information by Deadline 10 in the Examination Timetable, Monday 11 March 2024.
