

Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010
Application by SP MANWEB for an Order Granting Development Consent
for the North Wales Wind Farms Connection

Itinerary for the Accompanied Site Visit taking place on Tuesday 22
September and Wednesday 23 September 2015.

The Examining Authority (ExA) will make an inspection of the site in the company of interested parties in accordance with Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rule 16.

To maintain the probity of the examination, interested parties may not make representations to the ExA. They may highlight features which are not readily apparent.

Participants will be collected from Denbigh Town Hall for departure at 10:00am on both days, or may choose to meet the party at a single site by prior arrangement. At the end of the published route, the vehicle will return to Denbigh Town Hall.

There will be a lunch break on both days; participants are advised to bring their own lunches. It is anticipated that the visit will be concluded at dusk on Tuesday 22 and before 4pm on Wednesday 23 September.

Many of the visits will be to farms or fields. Please dress appropriately for the weather and site.

The ExA have endeavoured to meet all requests for site visits which they consider necessary. If it is not possible to visit all requested locations, a further visit may be arranged.

All locations are provided on the map overleaf. Locations to the south of Denbigh will be visited on day 1 (Tuesday 22 September). Clocaenog Substation will be the first stop and Gwaenynog Bach the final stop.

Locations to the North of Denbigh will be visited on day 2 (Wednesday 23 September). Bryn Llifanen will be the first stop and Rhyl Flats cable the final stop.

This itinerary is subject to change as detailed arrangements are made.
