Dear Sirs

I write again this morning after attending the Hearing in Denbigh last week to re-affirm my objection to the proposed overhead lines and Pylons from Clogaenog to St Asaph.

I have now seen the proposed positions of pylons past my property and can only be dismayed how near they are and how unfair the positioning is in relation to health issues and property value. Although SP Manweb proposes planting to mitigate the effect of the pylons there is no guarantee that they will be maintained and by who.

I also have in my possession hunting, shooting and sporting rights over 60 acres adjoining my property. I believe these will be interfered with by the overhead lines.

I would once again propose that this transmission line is placed underground as I believe from listening at the Hearing in Denbigh the advised increase in costs is debateable. I also would like make the point that the stress to the community is considerable by the proposed overhead lines and it should be taken into account.
