My interpretation of this statement is that it serves to illustrate that planting of trees will not mitigate against visual intrusion and the effects on tranquility from the development.

In my opinion the risks involved to the environment when wind farms and their grid connection are not assessed and examined together are illustrated here.  
There is a risk that these changes give the DCO greater scope than originally assessed for the Environmental Statement.

Perhaps the question that needs to be asked is how can this development be justified as the North Wales Wind Farm Connection project?It was originally intended for connection to four wind farms.
