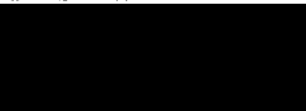

Dear Sirs

I write today with further comments on the proposed transmission line between Clocaenog and St Asaph.

The Planning Inspectorate panel visited my property to see the effect the power lines would have because of their proximity to my home. The trees on my land were in full leaf at the time. However now the leaves are down you can see the blight these poles will have on my outlook.

The proposed route skylines on either side of my home and will be visible especially during the winter months. SP Manweb have advised they will plant trees etc. to mitigate the effect but I believe they cannot guarantee this as who will manage these trees in the years to come and whose land will they plant on. My home is very old and is a fine example of a Welsh long house. In the past it was a mill and granary. I have spent a lot of time restoring and maintaining this property to create a pleasant place to live. I believe our environment will be hurt if the poles are erected.

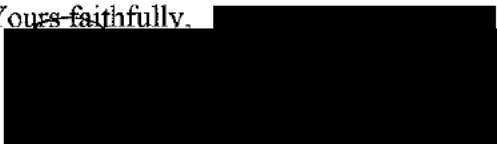
Also when you look across the landscape and consider the effect these poles will have on the landscape in general I believe the result will be a disaster for the area. We must remember that the landscape in North Wales is its wealth.

I also have with my property Sporting Rights covering the surrounding land. I attach a plan showing the area concerned. The proposed route goes through the middle of this area. See the letter from SP Manweb attached. I cannot agree with their acquisition of these Rights and that the power lines will have no effect. I have had a meeting with SP Manweb at my home and advised them of my objections.

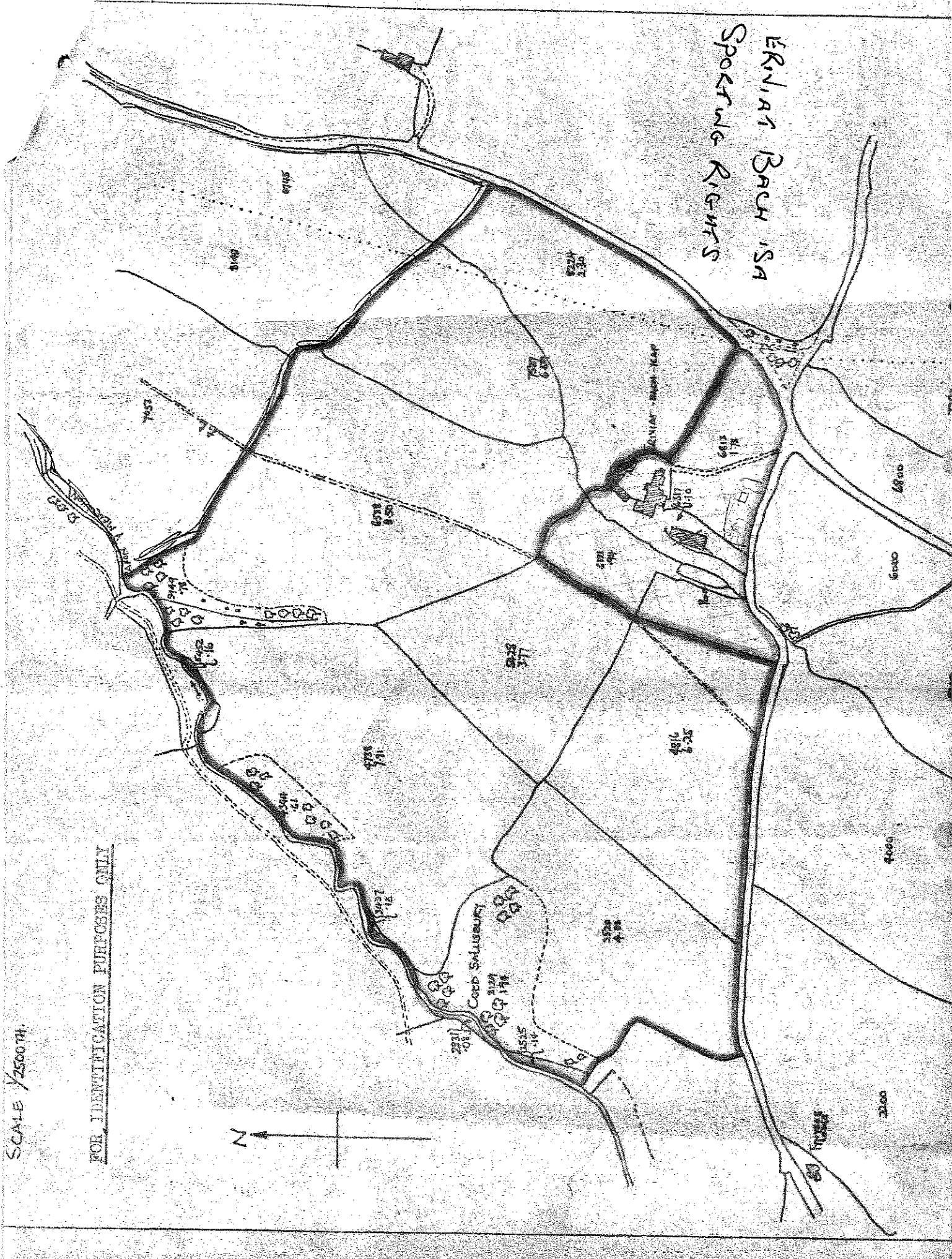
I am also concerned as I understand from the hearing last week in Denbigh that SP Manweb want to keep this line for over thirty years and have no plans for decommissioning as they want this line to be part of the National Grid for England and Wales. I was of the opinion that we have always been discussing a North Wales wind farm connection from Clocaenog to St Asaph.

I would therefore again express my objection to the proposed overhead route and would request that this line be placed underground.

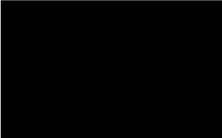

Proposed SP Manweb Plc North Wales Wind Farms Connection Order

We write in relation to the above project. As you will be aware, SP Manweb Plc ("**Manweb**") submitted an application for the Manweb North Wales Wind Farms Connection Order (the "**Order**"), which was formally accepted on 17 April 2015. We are writing to you in respect of your interest in the land to which the proposed Order relates. This land is shown on the enclosed plan marked FGC-378105-TP-43 and the rights you hold in this land are set out in the schedule attached to the plan. These rights are summarised as follows:

Hunting, shooting and sporting rights as contained in Conveyance dated 31 January 1973 for the benefit of Eriviat Bach Isaf ("**Sporting Rights**") as shown on plots 63, 63A, 63B, 63C.

We have become aware of these rights following on-going diligent enquiry as part of the revision of the Book of Reference, which was undertaken to enable the notification of acceptance of the application for development consent. The Book of Reference includes all interests in land in respect of which Manweb has included powers of compulsory acquisition in its application for the Order.

With regards to the Sporting Rights, we do not anticipate the Order will have any impact upon these. Should you consider that the Order may interfere with these rights however please do not hesitate to contact me to discuss this further.

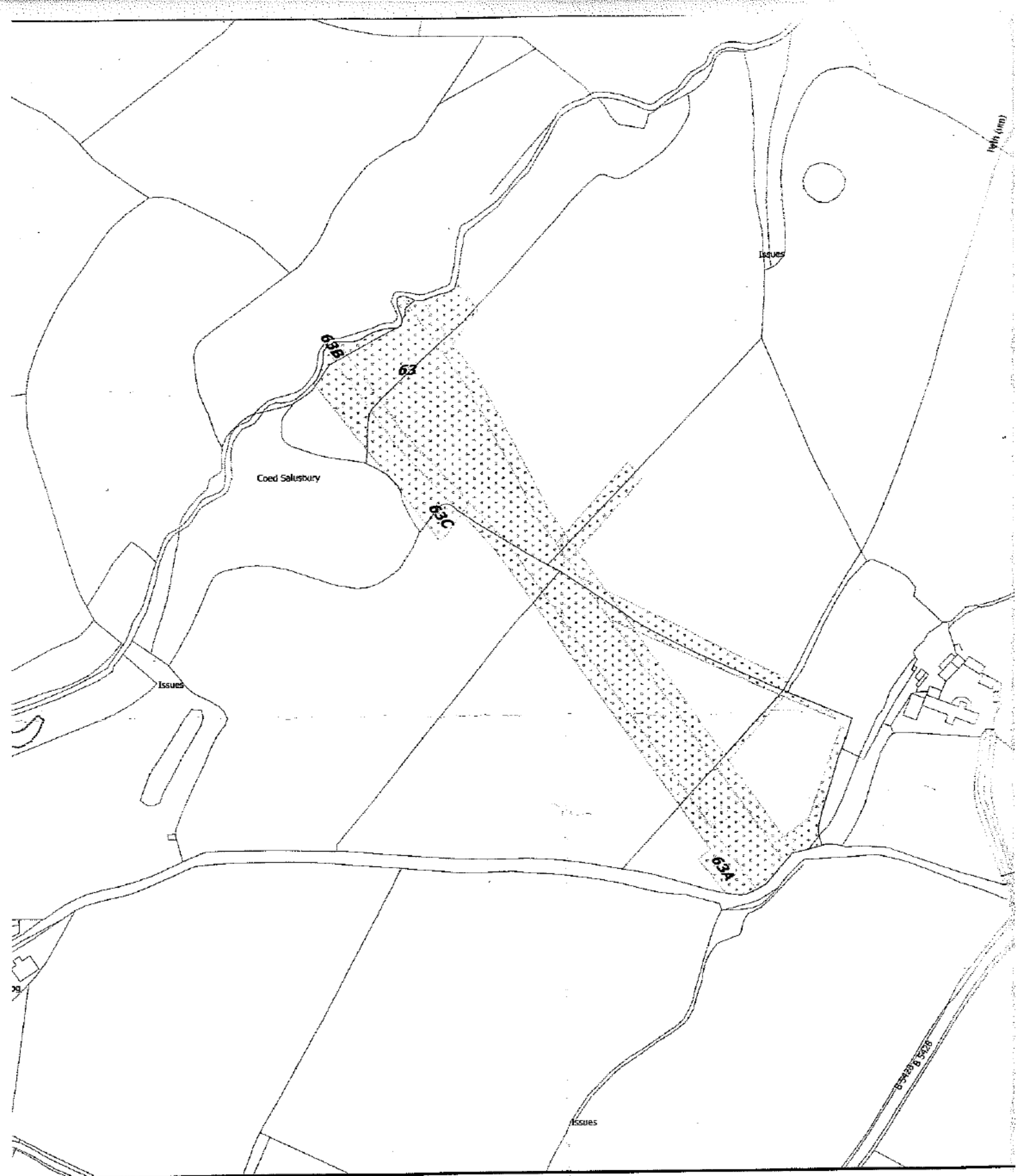
