

4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application

* Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

The application relates to the installation of a 400kV electricity connection. This will include a 400kV overhead line which is wholly in Wales. The line comes within s.16(1) of the Planning Act 2008 and is therefore a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project within s.14(1) of the Planning Act 2008 and requires a development consent order under s.31 of the Planning Act 2008.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

A new 400kV electricity connection to facilitate the proposed Wylfa Newydd Power Station from the National Grid substation at Wylfa to the National Grid substation at Pentir, Gwynedd. The proposed connection will be approximately 35km long and would be built using a combination of lattice pylons, a tunnel under the Menai Strait (with associated surface infrastructure) and improvements at existing National Grid substations at Wylfa and Pentir.

Associated works are also included in the proposed development, for example, temporary accesses, temporary highways works, temporary construction compounds, scaffolding, work sites, mitigation and ancillary works.

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development

The proposed development is wholly within Wales and crosses the administrative areas of the Isle of Anglesey County Council and Gwynedd Council.
