

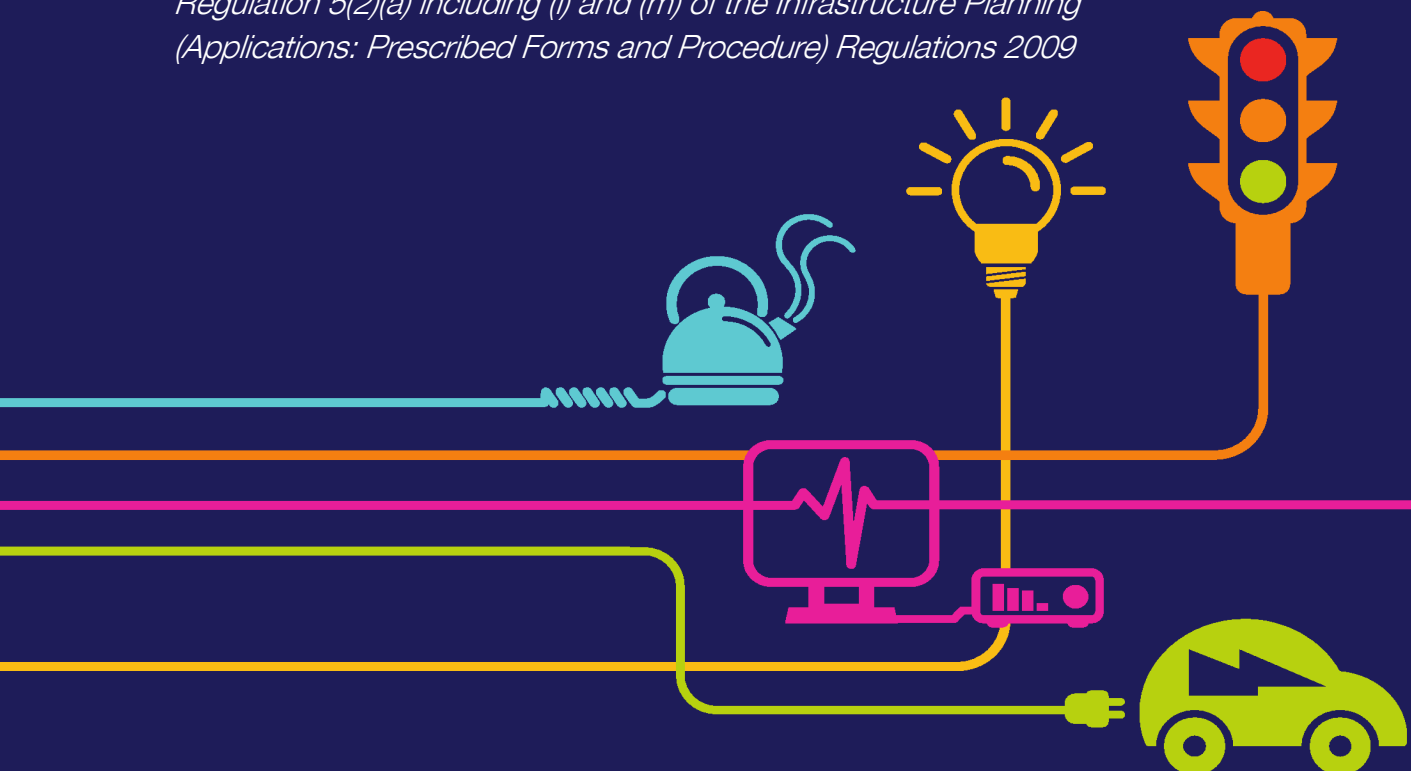

The Plan aims to, <i>“guide the development of housing, retail, employment and other land uses, include policies which will aid the Local Planning Authority’s decision with regard to planning applications and protect areas to ensure the maintenance and enrichment of the natural and built environment.”</i></p> <p>Policy PCYFF1 (Development Boundaries) of the Plan states that, <i>“planning permission will be refused where the proposed development would have an unacceptable adverse impact on... the health, safety or amenity of occupiers of local residences, other land and property uses or characteristics of the locality due to increased activity, disturbance, vibration, noise, dust, fumes, litter, drainage, light pollution, or other forms of pollution or nuisance”</i>.</p>	<p>The approach to assessing likely significant air quality effects is explained in section 4. The results are reported in sections 8, 9 and 10 and are summarised in section 11.</p> <p>The detailed air quality assessment methods are provided in Appendix 14.2 Construction Dust Assessment Method (<b>Document 5.14.2.2</b>) and Appendix 14.3 Detailed Air Quality Modelling Assessment (<b>Document 5.14.2.3</b>).</p>	<p>ES Chapter 14 Air Quality (<b>Document 5.14</b>) reports the findings of a comprehensive air quality assessment of the Proposed Development. The chapter confirms that there will be no unacceptable air quality effects as a result of the Proposed Development. Accordingly, the Proposed Development complies with Policy PCYFF1.</p>
