HYSBYSIAD BOD YR YSGRIFENNYDD GWLADOL WEDI DERBYN CAIS AM ORCHYMYN CANIATÂD DATBLYGU

Hysbysir trwy hyn bod cais gan National Grid Electricity Transmission plc (“National Grid”) o 1-3 Strand, Llundain, WC2N 5RH am Orchymyn Caniatâd Datblygu (“DCO”) o dan Ddeddf Cynllunio 2008 (“y Cais”) wedi’i dderbyn i’w archwilio gan yr Ysgrifennydd Gwladol. Cyflwynwyd y Cais gan National Grid i’r Ysgrifennydd Gwladol, d/o yr Arolygiaeth Gynllunio (“PINS”), ar 7 Medi 2018 ac fe’i derbyniwyd i’w archwilio ar 4 Hydref 2018. Cyfeirnod yr Arolygiaeth Gynllunio yw EN020015.

CRYNODEB O'R PROSIECT

Mae gan National Grid gytundeb cysylltu i gysylltu atomfa Wylfa Newydd â'r rhwydwaith trawsyrru presennol. Byddai’r DCO arfaethedig yn awdurdodi gwaith i gysylltu’r safle cynhyrchu hwn gan ddefnyddio cysylltiad newydd 400 kV, yn rhedeg o’r is-orsaf bresennol yn yr Wylfa, Ynys Môn i is-orsaf bresennol National Grid ym Mhentir, Gwynedd. Bwriedir i’r cysylltiad fod yn gyfuniad o linell uwchben a thwnnel o dan Afon Menai.

Gelwir y prosiect seilwaith newydd hwn yn Brosiect Cysylltiad Gogledd Cymru (“y Prosiect”) ac mae’n cynnwys y prif elfennau a ganlyn:

- Estyniadau i’r is-orsaf bresennol yn yr Wylfa;
- Tua 33 cilometr (20.5 milltir) o linell uwchben newydd 400 kV rhwng is-orsaf yr Wylfa ac Adeilad Pen Twannel a Chompownd Pennau Selio Ceblau Braint ar Ynys Môn, yn cynnwys addasu rhannau o’r llinell uwchben 400 kV bresennol rhwng yr Wylfa a Phentir;
- Adeilad Pen Twannel a Chompownd Pennau Selio Ceblau Braint ar Ynys Môn, a lôn fynediad barhaol;
- Twannel tua phedwar cilometr o hyd (2.5 milltir) rhwng Adeiladau Pen Twannel Braint a Thŷ Fodol;
- Adeilad Pen Twannel a Chompownd Pennau Selio Ceblau Tŷ Fodol yng Ngwynedd, a lôn fynediad barhaol;
- Darn newydd tua 1.6 cilometr (1 filltir) o linell uwchben newydd 400 kV rhwng Adeilad Pen Twannel a Chompownd Pennau Selio Ceblau Tŷ Fodol ac is-orsaf Pentir.
- Estyniad i is-orsaf bresennol Pentir; a
- Compowndiau adeiladu, lonydd mynediad, ardaloedd adeiladu a gweithiau trydydd parti dros dro sy’n angenrheidiol er mwyn adeiladu’r seilwaith a restrir uchod.

NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATION FOR A DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has accepted an application by National Grid Electricity Transmission plc (“National Grid”) of 1-3 Strand, London, WC2N 5RH for a development consent order (“DCO”) under the Planning Act 2008 (“the Application”). The Application was submitted by National Grid to the Secretary of State, c/o The Planning Inspectorate (“PINS”), on 7 September 2018 and was accepted on 4 October 2018. The PINS reference number is EN020015.

SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

National Grid has a connection agreement to connect Wylfa Newydd nuclear power station to the existing transmission network. The proposed DCO would authorise works to connect this generation by means of a new 400 kV connection running from the existing substation at Wylfa, Anglesey to the existing National Grid substation at Pentir, Gwynedd. The connection is proposed as a combination of overhead line and a tunnel beneath the Menai Strait.

This new infrastructure project is known as the North Wales Connection Project (“the Project”) and includes the following principal elements:

- Extensions to the existing substation at Wylfa;
- Approximately 33 kilometres (20.5 miles) of new 400 kV overhead line (OHL) between Wylfa substation and Braint Tunnel Head House and Cable Sealing End Compound on Anglesey, including modifications to parts of the existing 400 kV OHL between Wylfa and Pentir;
- Braint Tunnel Head House and Cable Sealing End Compound on Anglesey, and a permanent access track;
- An approximately four kilometres (2.5 mile) tunnel between Braint and Tŷ Fodol Tunnel Head Houses;
- Tŷ Fodol Tunnel Head House and Cable Sealing End Compound in Gwynedd, and a permanent access track;
- An approximately 1.6 kilometres (1 mile) new section of 400 kV overhead line between Tŷ Fodol Tunnel Head House and Cable Sealing End Compound and Pentir Substation;
- Extension to the existing substation at Pentir; and
- Temporary construction compounds, access tracks, construction working areas and third party works that are required to construct the infrastructure listed above.

ASESIAD O'R EFFAITH AMGYLCHEDDOL

Mae’r Prosiect yn “ddatblygiad AEA” at ddibenion Rheoliadau Cynllunio Seilwaith (Asesu Effeithiau Amgylcheddol) 2009. Mae hyn yn golygu bod y gwaith arfaethedig yn ddatblygiad y mae angen Aseiad o’r Effaith Amgylcheddol ar ei gyfer. Felly cyflwynwyd Datganiad Amgylcheddol gyda chais National Grid am Orchymyn Caniatâd Datblygu, ac yncdo’r wybodaeth angenrheidiol fel y gall yr Ysgrifennydd Gwladol wneud yr asesiad hwnnw.
