1. Cwblhau'r trafodaethau ynglŷn â'r ffordd orau ymlaen a grybwyllywd gan Andrew Webb, Cyfarwyddwr Gweithredol Horizon Nuclear Power, yn ei lythyr at yr Arolygiaeth Gynllunio dyddiedig 21 Ionawr 2019; a
2. chau cais Wylfa Newydd, gyda sicrwydd canlyniadol ynglŷn ag amrywiaeth o bynciau gan gynnwys y rhaglen adeiladu, symudiadau traffig cysylltiedig ac asesiad o effeithiau cronnol; a'r
3. Grid Cenedlaethol i drafod â'r awdurdodau lleol a rhanddeiliaid eraill perthnasol sut y gallai diwygiadau i gais Horizon effeithio ar y cais hwn; ac
4. amser i ddatblygu diwygiadau priodol i Gysylltiad Gogledd Cymru, os bydd angen, mewn ymgynghoriad ag eraill; a
5. digon o amser i Bartion â Buddiant ac unrhyw un arall y mae'r cais yn effeithio arno ystyried pa gynrychiolaethau y gallent ddymuno eu cyflwyno ar unrhyw ddiwygiadau yn y Cyfarfod Rhagarweiniol.

**APPLICATION BY NATIONAL GRID ELECTRICITY TRANSMISSION PLC FOR AN
ORDER GRANTING DEVELOPMENT CONSENT FOR THE NORTH WALES
CONNECTION PROJECT**

**PROCEDURAL DECISION MADE BY THE EXAMINING AUTHORITY UNDER
SECTION 89(3) PLANNING ACT 2008 (AS AMENDED) IN CONNECTION WITH
A REQUEST THAT THE PRELIMINARY MEETING SHOULD NOT OCCUR BEFORE
1 JUNE 2019**

We have received a request from the applicant, National Grid Electricity Transmission PLC, that the Preliminary Meeting (PM) should not occur before 1 June 2019. In summary, the applicant proposes that, in the light of a material change in circumstances regarding the development of the Wylfa Newydd project since the application was accepted by the Secretary of State for Examination, the PM should be delayed until June 2019 to allow for:

1. The completion of the discussions about the best way forward mentioned by Andrew Webb, Executive Director at Horizon Nuclear Power, in his letter to the Planning Inspectorate dated 21 January 2019; and
2. the closure of the Wylfa Newydd application, with consequent certainty about a range of topics including the construction programme, related traffic movements and cumulative impact assessment; and
3. National Grid to discuss with the local authorities and other relevant stakeholders how revisions to the Horizon application might affect this application; and
4. time to develop appropriate amendments to the North Wales Connection, if required, in consultation with others; and
5. sufficient time for Interested Parties and anyone else affected by the application to consider what representations they may wish to make on any revisions at the PM.

The purpose of the PM is, of course, to assist the Examining Authority (ExA) in determining how the application should be examined. It marks the start of the Examination which must thereafter run to a strict statutory timetable.

Before the ExA decides whether to accede to or reject this request, the views of all those persons who would be entitled to be invited to the PM and the views of any other person that the ExA intends to invite to that meeting are sought. This process will enable anyone who might potentially be affected by the applicant's request a fair opportunity to make their views known and have them properly taken into account. The ExA has made a procedural decision to the effect that such views should be sought in this way under section 89(3) of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended).

You are therefore invited to submit comments upon the applicant's request as outlined above by e-mail (NorthWalesConnection@pins.gsi.gov.uk) or by letter (address above)) **by 22 February 2019. Please note that your response must solely be in response to the applicant's request; we are not seeking further representations on the merits of the proposed development at this stage.**
