We are writing to Mr. Broderick as joint landowners with concern about the process that is taking place between Western Power Distribution Group and us and would wish for the Inspector to consider a fair process to the planning decision.

We have never had any objections to the idea of lines being installed underground but constructed over ground will take away the beautiful view we have of the valley not just due to our poles but the other poles around us.

We have been completely disregarded and not acknowledged by WPD Group Communications there has been a complete lack of communication we requested through our land agent many times. The Head of Terms we only received on November 13th 2015. We found the Head of Terms very vague just a summary of the Deeds of Grant also the Head of Terms do not reflect what we have been told There have been changes to the route alignment and number of poles and stays without us knowing.

Pressure is being put on land and property owners in signing these Head of Terms there is a clause that says if we sign this document we will not have a voice to object to the planning process. Many folk are extremely stressed now not aware of the implications of what they may be doing. This is becoming blackmail.

With a view from our extension which opens out onto a raised patio has been the talking point from all who visit this will be spoilt by all these poles and stays when erected. We have red kites nesting and breeding in the trees, will they be driven away?

We would like you to take into account all above and make sure that this process is conducted in a fair and equal manner.
