

Dear Mr. Broderick,

First we would like to make clear we appreciate that clean, renewable energy is a must for the future and we feel we all have a part to play and whilst wishing the line could be moved away from our farm we are sensible enough to realise it has to be placed somewhere. However, the way WPD has conducted itself in this venture leads us to question the sanity of our willingness to do our bit.

As a small dairy farm, we felt it only sensible we should seek advice and support as when we read the HoTs we felt it had to be wrong that WPD be given access to the whole of the farm if we were to sign. Unlike WPD we do not have the luxury of being able to afford a team of barristers and lawyers and therefore decided to turn to a land agent in Carmarthen. Our land agent has expressed landowner concerns and has tried his best to have amendments to the HoTs made.

The revised HoTs sent to our agent are still not to our satisfaction.

We pointed out to WPD in the Autumn of 2014 that the 1km section of the line was crossing through the middle of silage and grazing fields where there are land drains and also an oil pipeline. It is now January 2016 and we are still waiting for a visit from WPD.

We as a family feel strongly we can not sign the contract as it stands because we do not feel we should allow access to all land adjoining the Easement Strip or be required to protect electric lines and ancillary equipment and we should be able to grow crops of our choice on our land when we wish to.

We feel it is reasonable that we expect a visit from WPD, seek advice from an agent and that we do all we can to protect our only source of income-our dairy farm.

It is also an insult that a multimillion pound company like WPD, who stand to make millions more from this project feels we are not worthy of a reasonable amount of compensation for our inconvenience.

Once again thank you for taking the time to read this letter and for taking in to consideration our concerns.
