Please find attached a copy of a letter I sent to WPD last evening.

We want the Examining Authority to be aware.

I had looked at the new Landowner Communication Table 9.40 which was published on the PINS website yesterday. We are very unhappy that WPD have made multiple references in this public document in our specific entry referring to a 'boundary dispute', January and February 2016.

We don't have a boundary dispute with any of our neighbours and I have said in our letter we live in a very close community and the publication of this sort of thing can cause damage to reputation. We are very unhappy that this incorrect information is in the public domain.

There is also a reference to our request for ex. gratia survey payment in July 2015, which is also untrue. This is incorrect and requires removing from our record but is not such an issue for us.

We have requested that WPD address this and have asked for their confirmation.

Dear Mr Hubbard

Further to the Landowner Communication Table 9.40 which has been published on the PINS website today.

I have just looked at the document (10.15pm) and we are frankly shocked that in our entry there are multiple references to a boundary dispute. The entries relate to January and February 2016. We don't have a boundary dispute with our neighbours and have no idea what WPD are referring to. This is not true and is not the sort of information which should be published in the public domain unless it can be substantiated. We live in a close community and publication of something like this can cause damage to reputation and is clearly a libel.

Additionally, there is an entry for July 2015 which states that we requested an ex gratia survey payment. We certainly didn't and at that time our Agent was R.Rees of Swansea and until the Agent met with us accompanied by WPD in September 2015 and presented us with the HoTs to sign, we don't think there had been any contact between us for six months or more. This entry is incorrect and should be removed.

We request that this document is re-called, withdrawn from the public domain and our entry is revised before it is re-submitted. We can only think that there has been a major administrative error.

There is additional correspondence we have sent to WPD which is not listed in the table and we will advise the Examining Authority regarding this under separate cover.

Please can you confirm your attention to this matter.
