Dear Chris

In one of our previous submissions we questioned the inclusion of a property called "Summer Hill" in National Grid's list of listed buildings in Broad Oak. The only property which I had been able to find on the Canterbury City Council register of listed buildings with that name was in a different part of the Canterbury district entirely. Following correspondence from National Grid with helpful links to the Historic England website, I have now been able to identify this property, which is in Broad Oak, on the western side of Shalloak Road close to its junction with Sweechgate.

The Richborough Connection will have a detrimental effect on the environment of this listed building. Both pylons PC7 and PC8 will be visible from the rear of the property, which at its closest will only be 350m from the route of the proposed overhead line.

I would be grateful if this could be brought to the attention of the Inspectors.
