I am an interested party as the proposed route goes through my farm and would like to make the following points with reference to agreeing terms;

1. They only seem to want what they want and don't seem to care about anything else. They just say they'll use compulsory purchase rather than trying to negotiate.
2. They need to stop using bullying tactics.
3. The temporary construction compounds are being placed down small byways and minor roads, why can't they sight them off bigger highways and use their internal track which they're going to install? This would minimise the effect on local people.
4. They have no drainage plan, they should do a demonstration of how they intend to mend a land drain which has been cut through 6 times and still keep it working.
5. They only want to pay compensation for the land rights after the work is done, they should pay before the work commences.
