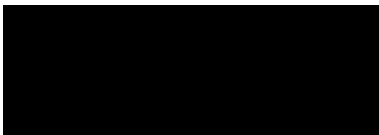
Thank you for directing our attention to the electric and magnetic field (EMF) assessment information provided with your application.
