Discussions regarding the potential Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm export cable route and the potential impact on marine aggregate extraction from Westminster Gravels Limited Licence Area 515/1 are ongoing. A statement of common ground has already been submitted and a mitigation and compensation package is under review. It is hoped both parties can settle any potential conflict and reach agreement with a suitable Offshore Export Cable Compensation And Co-operation Agreement prior to the final Hearings scheduled for January. Without an Agreement, Westminster Gravels Limited will potentially wish to submit evidence during the course of TKES Public Hearings scheduled for January 2016.
