Please consider this letter as our corporate response to the questions that require our attention.

Question Number: DCO 2.31

Topic Heading: Schedule 9 - Condition 8(1)

Question: Directed to the Applicant; Historic England; and Lincolnshire CC – “The Applicant has amended the wording of Condition 8(1) regarding timescales for provisions of reports to OASIS and notification to Lincolnshire County Council. Indicate your acceptance, or otherwise, of this proposed amendment.”

We understand from a representative of the Applicant (P. Carter Esq of RWE), in email correspondence of 1st December 2015, that the following wording is now incorporated into the Development Consent Order/deemed Marine Licence submitted to the Planning Inspectorate in accordance with Deadline III (30th November 2015). 8. — Any archaeological reports produced in accordance with condition 7(g)(iii) are to be agreed with the HBMCE.

(1) The undertaker must ensure that a copy of any agreed archaeological report is deposited with the National Record of the Historic Environment (NRHE), by submitting a Historic England OASIS form with a digital copy of the report within 6 months of the completion of construction of the authorised scheme. If the report relates to the intertidal area the undertaker must notify the MMO and Lincolnshire County Council that the OASIS report has been submitted to the NRHE within two weeks of the submission.

We hereby state that we are satisfied by the amendment made to this condition, as set out in the text above and we have no further comment or other advice to offer.

Question Number: AH 2.8

Topic Heading: Draining Scoop Wheel and Channel

Question: Directed to: East Lindsey DC; Historic England; and Heritage Trust for Lincolnshire – “Confirm that the heritage asset is incorrectly plotted and the Applicant’s assertion that there would be no impact to the heritage asset from the TCC¹.”

We can confirm that the Listed Building 3/12 Drainage Scoop Wheel and Channel north of Denegate House (TF234455) is correctly described, but incorrectly located in the stated grid reference and on plan. We will therefore correct the data at <https://historicengland.org.uk/listing/the-list/list-entry/1062051> as soon as possible.

We had plotted the asset at NGR: TF2340045500, but we can confirm the listed structure is clearly shown and labelled ‘Draining Pump’ at TF2332545560 on overlay of the 1:2500 scale Ordnance Survey maps dated 1889 and 1905 and on the current OS 1:2500 mapping as ‘Draining Pump Disused’.

On this basis we are content with the applicant’s understanding of location and that basis for assessing impact, it is for the applicant to demonstrate their case that given the corrected location, harm will not occur due to screening by the intervening private residence (or that any harm would be both temporary and negligible). It should be noted that the faced channel integral with the remains of the drainage pump forms part of the listed building.
