

With reference to your 10th February 2016 letter, I would like to make the following response to DCO 3.1 by way of comment on Article 13 Schedule 1:Part 3:Requirement 5(11) of the draft DCO referred to in your letter. This refers, inter alia, to the cable route, part of which crosses my field OS Number TF 5268.

I have made several representations both orally and in writing about this section of the proposed cable route (which are shown in more detail on your web site). I have spoken with Mr Ian Baker, Electrical Package Manager for the scheme, and have had accompanied site visits with, amongst others, Mr Martin Knagg, scheme overseeing engineer. My suggestions for a re-routing of that portion of the cable which passes over my land have, I believe, been favourably received. My understanding was that it could be possible for the proposed cable route to be varied along the lines proposed by me and discussed as mentioned above.

I would like to table a question in order to now elicit a clear response to this issue, which is of considerable importance and concern to me.
