Triton Knoll responses to 3rd Written questions on behalf of East Lindsey District Council

Set out below are the Council's responses as requested.

Relevant Questions

DCO 3.1 All Parties The ExA have issued their recommended draft Development Consent Order (DCO) in the form of a Schedule of ExA's recommended amendments to the Applicant's draft DCO version F. a) All parties are requested to provide comments and, if relevant, suggestions for amendments to the entirety of the ExA's recommended draft DCO. b) In particular, all parties are requested to provide comments and, if relevant, suggestions for amendments to wording to the ExA's recommended additional wording, including a recommended new Requirement on local employment. c) All parties are also requested to check the Schedule of ExA's recommended amendments to the Applicant's draft DCO version F taken with the Applicant's Revised draft DCO [REP5-035] and inform the ExA if they consider that any matters that they have raised in respect to the draft DCO during the course of the Examination have not been dealt with.

Response – a) Having checked the entirety of the ExA's recommended Draft DCO, East Lindsey has no additional comments to make.

b) East Lindsey welcome the inclusion of the requirement for a local employment scheme which echoes comments and submissions made by the District throughout the Inquiry. The wording, which requires the submission of a scheme is acceptable to the District and requires no change.

c) East Lindsey District consider that all matters raised by them during the course of the Inquiry have been satisfactorily addressed in the Panels amendments to the Draft DCO.

DCO 3.2 All Parties The Applicant's Revised draft DCO [REP5-035] included an amended version of the Restrictive Covenant at Schedule 5. This is included unchanged in the ExA's recommended draft DCO at this stage. The ExA requests that all parties including, in particular, affected landowners and tenants provide comments and, if relevant, suggestions for amendments to wording to the draft Restrictive Covenant.

Response – East Lindsey have no comments to make upon the amended version of the DCO insofar as the restrictive covenant is concerned
