Burgh le Marsh Town Council reiterates and supports the grave concerns expressed by other parishes within East Lindsey in respect of the detrimental impact the cable route and attendant works will have, both in terms of hampering the local economy which is heavily dependent on tourism and the trade generated by visitors to the area as well as disrupting the lives of residents and businesses as traffic and pedestrian movements are diverted and halted for extended periods of time. The Council also questions the adequacy of the consultation and whether the tourist base for the area (largely residents from neighbouring counties such as Yorkshire, Leicestershire and Derbyshire) was consulted on the potential impact of these works on their choice of East Lindsey as a holiday destination district; the results of such an inquiry would surely serve as indicators of the extent of the economic impact of this development.
