**Application reference: EN020019: Triton Knoll Electrical System
Request by the Applicant to amend the draft Development Consent Order**

Dear Katherine

Following the close of the examination on 3 March 2016, Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm Limited ("the Applicant") has carried out a review of the final draft Development Consent Order and Deemed Marine Licence - Revision G ("DCO") [REP7-018] together with the application plans. In doing so, the Applicant has noted two minor inconsistencies between the descriptions of the stages of works in Part 3 of Schedule 1 of the draft DCO and the Works Plans [REP7-011]. The stages of works are shown correctly on the Works Plans however, the descriptions of stages (h) Work No 11 and (i) Work No 14 in the draft DCO do not accord precisely with the Works Plans as the temporary construction compounds ("TCC") listed in the draft DCO to be used for those stages are incorrect.

The Applicant therefore requests that the following changes are made to the draft DCO:-

- a) Stage (h) Work No 11 - deletion of reference to the TCC at Work No 13; and
- b) Stage (i) Work No 14 – inclusion of the TCC at Work No 13 and deletion of reference to access at Work No 16.

The Applicant also proposes the following changes to the draft DCO to provide further clarification for these stages:-

- c) Stage (a) the IEC enabling works – to include reference to the TCC at Work No 10;
- d) Stage (b) the substation enabling works - to include reference to the TCC at Work No 51; and
- e) Stage (j) Work No 17 - to include reference to the access at Work No 16.

The proposed changes to the draft DCO are set out in Table 1 of Appendix 1 to this letter.

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These changes are not material. The changes sought do not include or require any change to the proposed development, the works, order limits or its environmental effects. The positions of the temporary construction compounds on the Works Plans are accurate and did not change during the examination, however these were not properly reflected in the drafting of the DCO. The changes proposed to the draft DCO wording ensures that it accurately captures the information contained on the Works Plans.

The Applicant has submitted along with this request a clean version of the revised draft DCO (Revision H) and a Comparison of Revision G and Revision H of the draft DCO showing the proposed amendments.

The Applicant is aware that these changes cannot be considered by the Examining Authority and requests that this letter and the supporting documents are provided to DECC along with the Examining Authority's report and recommendation. The Applicant requests that DECC make these changes to any Order that may be granted.

(f) Work No 9	Deletion of comma:- Work No 9, (excluding the IEC enabling works and Work No 9A using the temporary construction compound at Work No 10);	Correct minor typographical error.
(h) Work No 11	Deletion of temporary construction compound:- Work No 11 (using the temporary construction compounds at Work Nos 12 and 13);	Correct reference to temporary construction compounds for this stage to reflect what is shown on the Works Plans.
(i) Work No 14	Amendment of temporary construction compound number:- Work No 14 (using the temporary construction compounds <u>s</u> at Work Nos <u>13 and 15</u> and access at Work No 16);	Correct reference to temporary construction compounds for this stage to reflect what is shown on the Works Plans.
(j) Work No 17	Inclusion of additional text:- Work No 17 <u>(using the access at Work No 16);</u>	To provide further detail and specify the access for this stage.
