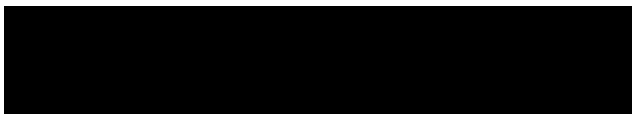
The deadline date for all representations to be received by the Secretary of State for Business Energy and Industrial Strategy under section 56 was ## February 2019.
