4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application

* Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

Electricity Interconnectors are not specifically listed in the Planning Act 2008 (as amended) (the 'PA 2008') and are therefore not by default classified as Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects ('NSIPs'). However, under Section 35(1) of the PA 2008, "[t]he Secretary of State may give a direction for development to be treated as development for which development consent is required". This is subject to the provisions of Sections 35 and 35ZA.

On 19 June 2018, the Applicant submitted a request for a direction pursuant to Section 35 to the SoS for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy ('BEIS') for the Proposed Development to be treated as development for which development consent is required.

On 30 July 2018, the SoS directed that "the proposed Development, together with any development associated with it, is to be treated as development for which development consent is required". A copy of the Section 35 direction is appended to the Planning Statement (document reference 5.4) at Appendix 3 (document reference 5.4.3).

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

AQUIND Interconnector (the 'Project') is an Interconnector with a nominal net capacity of 2,000 MW between Great Britain and France located off the coast of Portsmouth (marine) and between Portsmouth and Lovedean Substation (onshore). The components of the Project located within the UK and the UK Marine Area for which development consent is sought are referred to as the Proposed Development.

('ES') contains a detailed description of the Proposed Development. In broad terms, it includes:

- The Marine Cable consisting of two HVDC Circuits from the boundary of the UK Exclusive Economic Zone ('EEZ') to the UK at Eastney in Portsmouth;
- Jointing of the HVDC Marine Cables and the HVDC Onshore Cables;
- The Onshore Cable consisting of two HVDC Circuits;
- A Converter Station and associated electrical and telecommunications infrastructure;
- HVAC Cables, and associated infrastructure connecting the Converter Station to the Great Britain electrical transmission network, the National Grid, at Lovedean Substation and;
- Fibre Optic Cable ('FOC') together with each of the HVDC and HVAC Circuits and associated infrastructure.

The Marine Components of the Proposed Development are all of that part below the Mean High Water Springs (MHWS). The Onshore Components of the Proposed Development are all of that part landward from the Mean Low Water Springs (MLWS).

The application site (the 'Site') is shown on the Site Location Plan (document reference 2.1) submitted with the Application. The Works Plans (document reference 2.4) show the Order Limits and, within these, where applicable, the Limits of Deviation ('LOD') for each works package.

The Onshore Cable Route stretches across the administrative boundaries of the following local authorities:

- Winchester City Council ('WCC')
- East Hampshire District Council ('EHDC')
- Havant Borough Council ('HBC')
- Portsmouth City Council ('PCC')
- Hampshire County Council ('HCC')

South Downs National Park ('SDNP'), administered by the South Downs National Park Authority ('SDNPA'), is located to the north-west of the proposed Converter Station. Due to the linear nature of the Proposed Development, the Onshore Components are located within a variety of different areas with varying land uses and physical characteristics. These are described in Chapter 2 of the Planning Statement (document reference 5.4).
