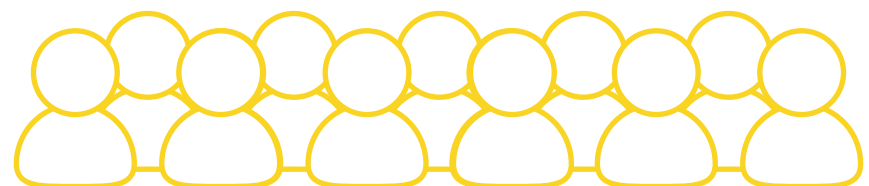

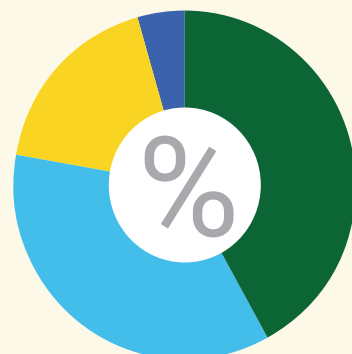

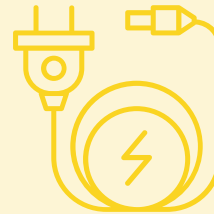
61% strongly agree or agree with the approach to the converter station design
