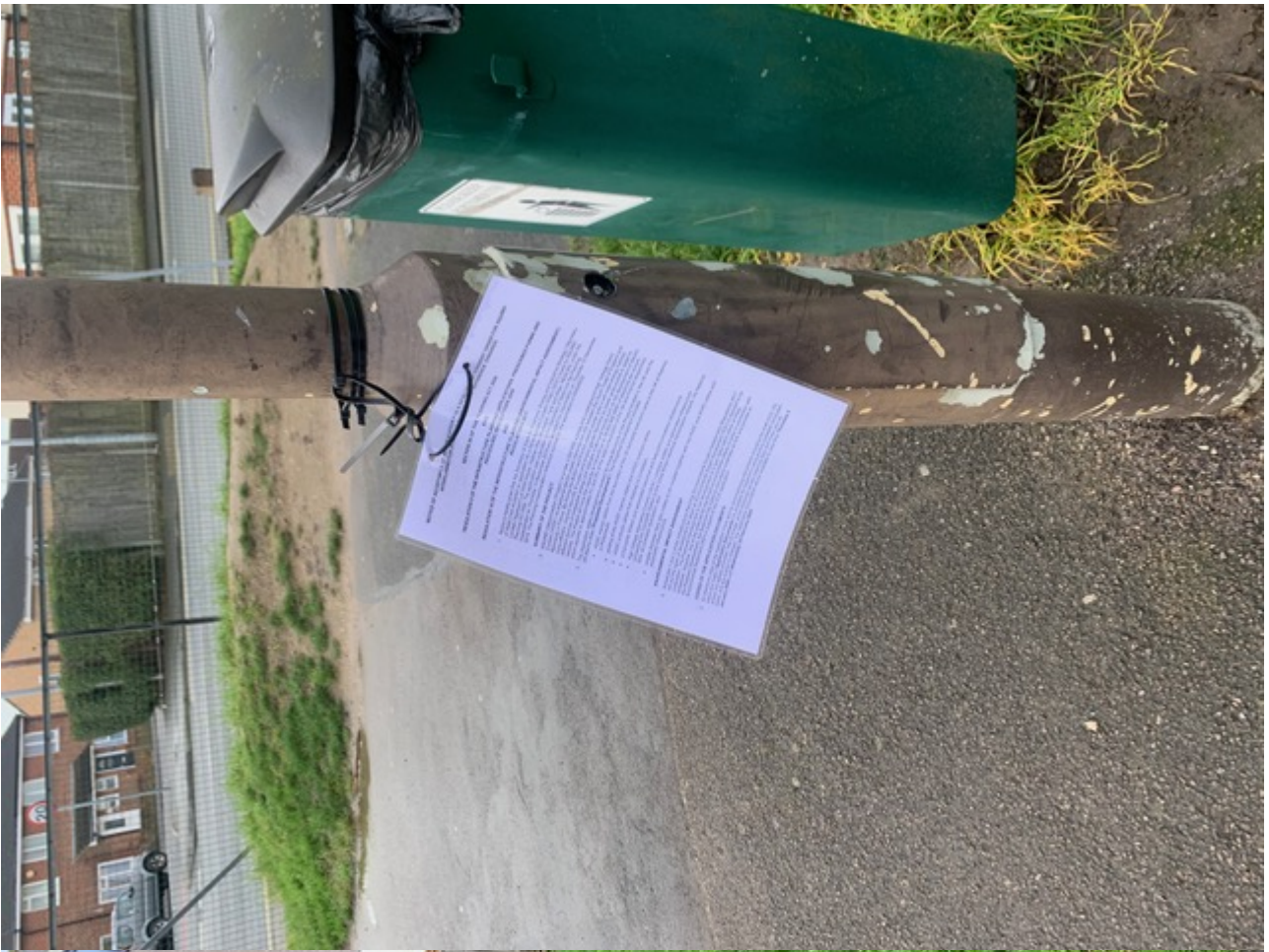
Following the completion and submission of a deputation form by myself, I wish to draw your attention to a number of signs that have 'mysteriously' appeared along the route of the proposed interconnector.

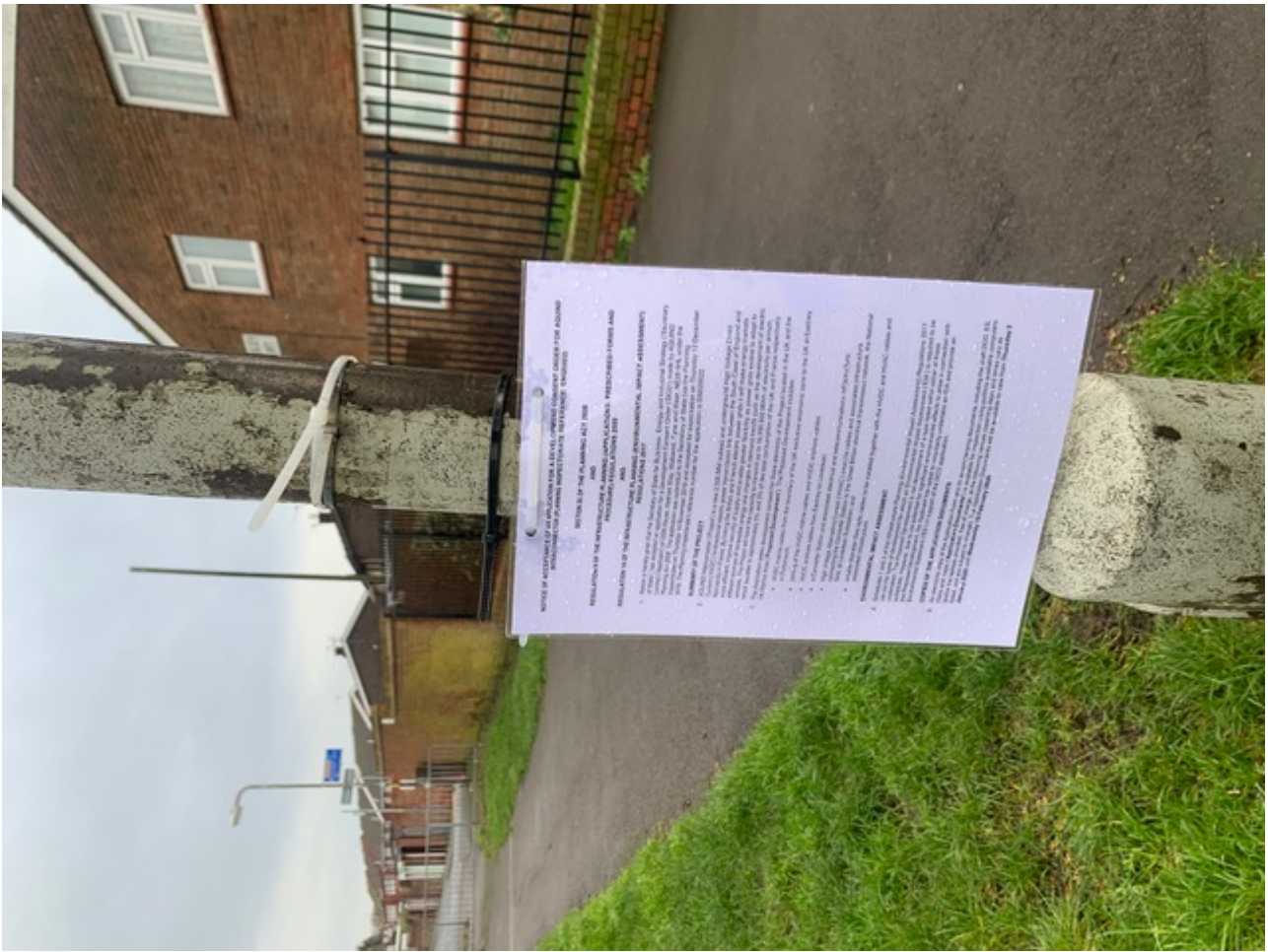
The signs were only put up towards the end of last week, at the end of the consultation period, have been badly positioned and fail to reasonably display contact details, as these have been printed either by design or carelessly on the reverse of the A4 notice, which has then been capable tied to a lamppost.

In at least one location, the sign has been set below waist height, while another was put at an angle that made reading text difficult.

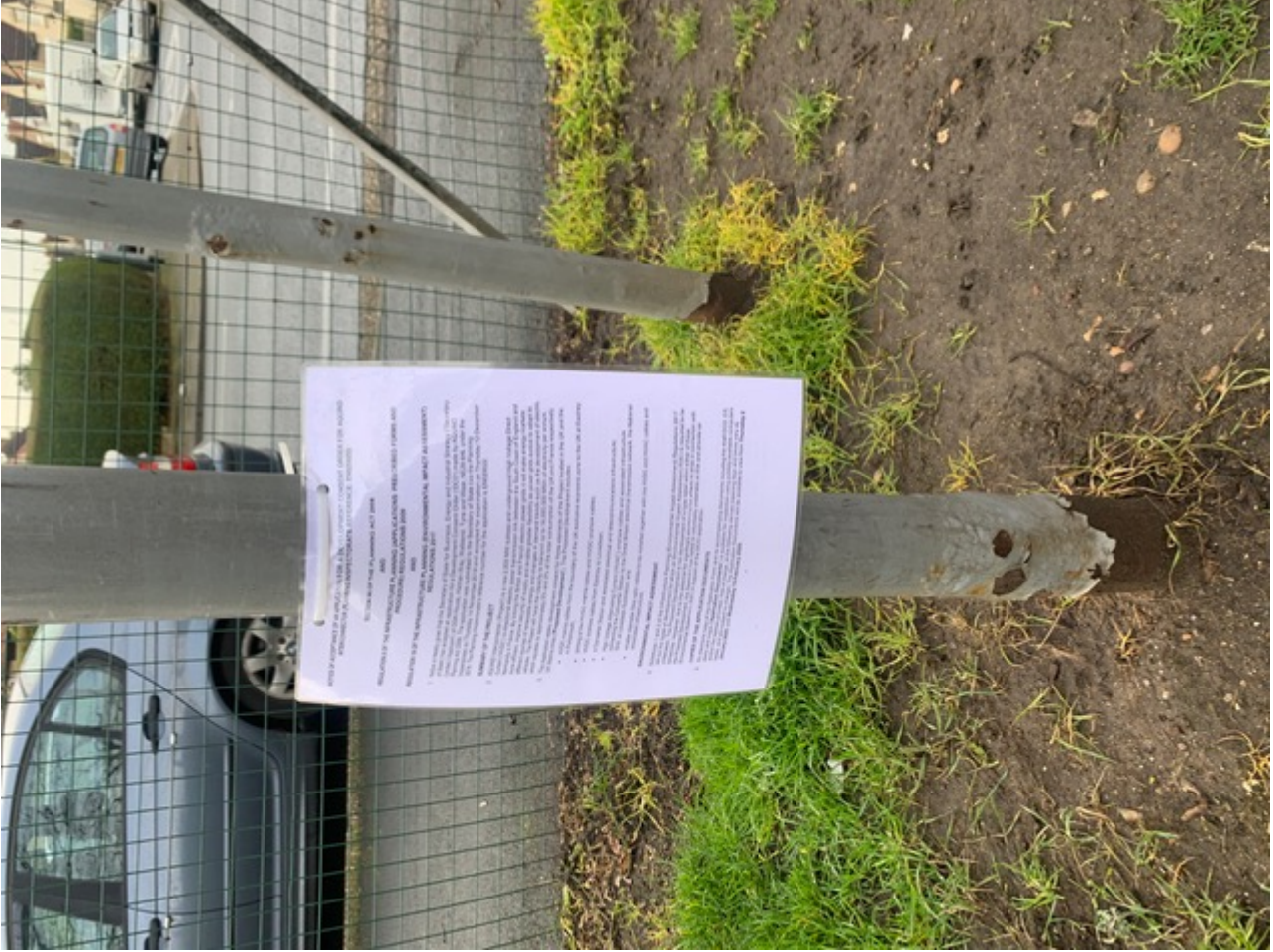
I attach some images which I took on Saturday morning.
