Schedule 15 Part 4 S. 3	Pre-construction plans and documentation	Reference to the 'marine emergency action card' should be removed. This is a document between MCA and Aquind and approval does not need to be via MMO. MCA will ensure it is completed via the remaining wording of this condition. This is consistent with the arrangements for the ERCoP requirement with other projects.
Schedule 15 Part 4 S. 10(3)	Post-Construction Surveys	Sonar is not a MCA requirement for meeting IHO Order 1a Standard
Schedule 15 Part 4 S. 13(10)	Maintenance of the Authorised Development	Hydrographic survey data must be submitted to MCA for confirmation of IHO standards. Suggest the following is included: This should fulfil the requirements of MGN 543 and its supporting 'Hydrographic Guidelines for Offshore Developers', which includes the requirement for the full density data and reports to be delivered to the MCA and the UKHO for the update of nautical charts and publications This must be submitted as soon as possible, and no later than [three months] prior to construction. The Order Limit shapefiles must be submitted to MCA. The Report of Survey must also be sent to the MMO.

Please find attached a copy of the draft DCO with our comments. These comments are consistent with an agreed set of conditions with the MMO, UKHO, Trinity House and MCA, however, should the applicant wish to discuss them further we would be happy to provide any clarification.
