INTRODUCTION

AQUIND Interconnector - Compulsory Acquisition Status Report

This document has been prepared to provide the status of negotiations and agreements for permanent or temporary rights required for the Proposed Development as at Deadline 4 as requested by the ExA pursuant to the Rule 6 letter issued on 3 July 2020.

- 1 Column A details the ID Number assigned to the Landowner or Organisation
- 2 Column B details the name of the Landowner or Organisation as listed in the Book of Reference
- 3 Column C identifies the reference number assigned to any Written Representation in the examination library
- 4 Column D identifies the Part of the Book of Reference where the interest is listed
- 5 Column E identifies the Class of rights to be acquired (i.e. Permanent and Temporary)
- 6 Column F identifies the relevant Plot Number in the Book of Reference where the interest is listed
- 7 Column G identifies if Compulsory Acquisition powers are sought over the Plot
- 8 Column H identifies the status of agreement. The short status descriptions are further clarified below;

Heads of Terms Issued- The Applicant has issued an offer of terms for a Voluntary agreement

Heads of Terms Agreed – The Applicant has agreed the principle terms of a Voluntary agreement and Solicitors have been instructed to issue legal agreements

Heads of terms in Negotiation- The Applicant has issued an offer of terms for a Voluntary Agreement and is engaged in active negotiations with the landowner or their representatives

Legal Drafting in Progress- Terms of a Voluntary agreement are agreed in principle, Solicitors are instructed and the legal agreement is being finalised

Option Agreement signed- The legal agreement has been exchanged and completed

PP in negotiation- The Applicant is negotiating Protective Provisions with the relevant stakeholder.

SOCG in negotiation- The Applicant has issued a Statement of Common Ground which is being discussed with the affected party

The Status Report does not include any subsoil interests beneath the land which forms the highway. These parties are identified in the Book of Reference (APP-022) and have been consulted as per the requirements of s.42 and s.56 of the Planning Act 2008. Further information in relation to the approach to be taken to acquiring subsoil interests is provided in the Highway Subsoil Acquisition Position Statement (REP1-131).

Please note the Book of Reference has been updated at Deadline 4 to specifically exclude the compulsory acquisition of interests of the local Highway Authorities vested in them in that capacity. As such, the Applicant has deleted the plots in which the extent of the land within the order limits is wholly vested in Hampshire County Council and Portsmouth City Council as Highway Authorities from this Status Report, noting the Applicant is still seeking to be granted the ability to compulsorily acquire rights over the subsoil interests of these plots in the event it will be necessary for the construction, operation and maintenance of the Proposed Development. Where a plot consists of land vested in the Highway Authority and land not vested in the Highway Authority it has been retained in the Status Report.
