Planning Act 2008 and The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010

Application for Development Consent ("the Application") by AQUIND Limited ("the Applicant") for an Order granting Development Consent for the proposed AQUIND Interconnector ("the AQUIND Interconnector project")

- 1. On 4 November 2021, the Secretary of State for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy ("the Secretary of State") issued a request for further information to the Applicant. The Applicant provided its response on 18 November 2021.
- 2. The Secretary of State now invites comments from **Interested Parties** on the information submitted by the Applicant.
- 3. The Secretary of State would, in particular, like to request responses from specific parties on certain topics, details of which are set out below.

North Portsea Island Coastal Defence Scheme

4. The Secretary of State requests that **Portsmouth City Council** and **Coastal Partners** provide their comments on the information submitted by the Applicant regarding the North Portsea Island Coastal Defence Scheme, including their views on the proposed Co-Operation Agreement.

Converter Station at Lovedean

- 5. The Secretary of State requests that **NGET** provides its comments on the information submitted at Section 5 of the Applicant's response regarding the agreement for the Applicant to purchase land rights over Plot 1-27 which is linked to the location of the converter station at Lovedean.
