

Sirs,

This is a formal objection to Aquind's proposal for the pipeline through Portsmouth and surrounding areas to Lovedean.

I still insist that Aquind have failed to consult with me as a householder who will be directly impacted by the pipeline on my property boundary. They have sent no communication to me as the homeowner, or this address.

I object in principle to the partnership with French energy supply. The political sway and manipulation potential of this 'partnership' is unacceptable and ripe for abuse by either side.

I am disatisfied by the lack of health and safety information relating to the cables and their function and maintenance requirements. I have a family to consider and the pipeline is too close to their home for me to find this lack of information negligible.

Aquind have donated  $\pounds 30,000$  to a local playground rejuvenation project. This is highly inappropriate whilst a decision is pending. It is nothing less than a payment to secure permission. It should be refused or withdrawn to at least pretend this is an impartial decision.

I object due to the blatant disregard for environmental protection. This is a densely populated city and surrounding areas. Green space is precious and much utilised. Aquind cannot put their speculative pipeline benefits ahead of tangible and current benefits of our green space.

In short, this project is flawed and has been managed appallingly arrogantly. I hope permission is denied and the proposal put to rest.
