I have lived in Portsmouth for almost a year. I like this nice city and I was concerned to hear that project Aquind may negatively impact the local life.

I am against Aquind project because:

- 1. Aquind wants to build a big electricity cable between Portsmouth and France, which will take a long time to construct and cause a lot of disruption to the city.
