I OBJECT IN THE STRONGEST POSSIBLE TERMS to Aquind's proposal to install cables, designed to carry 2 million watts of electricity, from Eastney Beach, Portsmouth and to dig trenches and drill tunnels from the landing-place, South to North in the City and further to route the trenching through urban areas outside of the City in order to connect to The National Grid at Lovedean, Hampshire.

The controversial Aquind Connector proposal includes tunnelling under important community facilities and protected habitats, digging deep and disruptive trenches, gouging through vital road links, though dense urban areas and designated areas for recreation and nature.
