I actually live in Waterlooville and the back up of traffic across the region affected all roads, with 10minute journeys taking up to an hour.

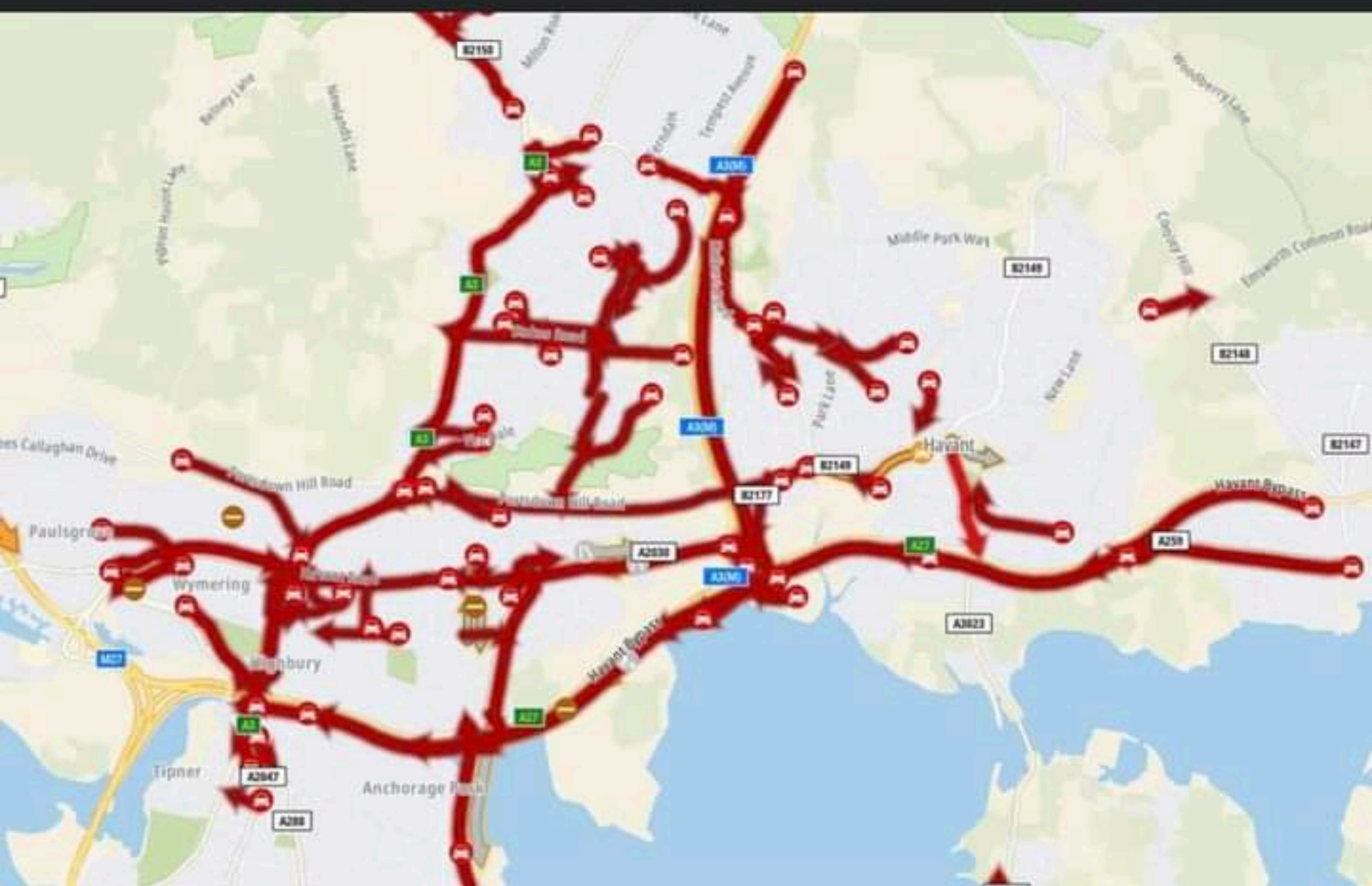
This level of congestion cannot be allowed.




