Langstone Harbour is a base for all kinds of wading birds such as Brent Geese, Redshank and Curlew during the Winter. Imagine the harm that your proposals would do to these birds who choose to spend their winter here.

As someone who use the Eastern Rd daily, I know that any construction work in that part of the city will cause a great deal of congestion and traffic misery for commuters. For this reason, I object to your proposal.
