4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application



* Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

The Project is defined as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) under Section 14(1)(b) and Section 16 of the Planning Act 2008 (the Act) as it comprises new overhead electricity transmission connections in England of more than 2 kilometres in length, with an operating voltage above 132 kilovolts (kV). Under Section 31 of the Act, development consent is required for development to the extent that it is or forms part of an NSIP.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development



* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The Proposed Development will consist of a new substation at Overton (Overton Substation), cable sealing end compounds (CSECs) and new overhead lines connecting into Overton substation (including a 2.8km 400kV overhead line and two 275kV overhead lines 1.5 - 2.1km in length). Also included in the Proposed Development is removal of existing 275kV overhead line, realignment and refurbishments of existing overhead line within the areas of North West of York, Poppleton, Tadcaster and Monk Fryston. Two new CSECs are proposed at Tadcaster, along with a new substation at Monk Fryston, and realignment of 275kV and 400kV overhead lines in this location. The Proposed Development will also include other associated works at the existing Osbaldwick Substation.

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development



* Description of location of application site(s), or route of development (reference to appropriate plans)

The Project is sited within Yorkshire, with the most northerly components located approximately 1.5km north-east of the village of Shipton-by-Beningbrough and approximately 10km north-west of York city centre. The most southerly components are at the existing Monk Fryston Substation, located to the east of the A1 and immediately south of the A63. The Project is located within the administrative boundaries of Hambleton District Council, City of York Council, Harrogate Borough Council, Selby District Council, Leeds City Council and North Yorkshire County Council.

The site location is illustrated on the Overall Location Plan (Volume 2, Document 2.1) and the Master Key to Section Identification Plan (Volume 2, Document 2.2). A description of the Project location is provided in ES Chapter 3: Description of the Project (Volume 5, Document 5.2.3).
