#### Annex A

### Participating in hearings

You must register by **Deadline 3 (Wednesday 10 May 2023)** if you wish to attend the hearing(s).

Please register using our website, if possible, or email us directly.

- Click on the *Make a submission tab* on the project page.
- The 'Submission item' will be DEADLINE 3.
- Please name your request appropriately e.g. 'Register to attend hearing'.

## Please provide us with:

- The hearing(s) you will be attending.

- If you are representing a person or organisation also provide their name and reference number.
