1. About this document

1.1 Introduction

1.1.1 This document provides National Grid Electricity Transmission plc's (National Grid) (the Applicant) list of all objections to the grant of Compulsory Acquisition or Temporary Possession made on the Yorkshire Green Energy Enablement Project (Yorkshire GREEN or the Project).
